



The Best Practices Showcase concept was created by the Florida Pioneer Network to explore AND share alternative care models which have proven effective for older adults in Florida.

A best practice is any food and dining initiative that a Caring Community has developed which improves lives or living conditions through a process which involves those who are being served.

A best practice fosters cooperative efforts that enhance excellence and innovation in care. A best practice may involve personal rights, provision of care, or administrative practices which result in improved person-centered care. Organizations may be nominated by others or they may self-nominate.

Entrants into the showcase must be providing services in Florida and within the following categories:

- Skilled Nursing Centers
- Assisted Living Facilities
- Palliative/Hospice Providers
- Continuing Care Retirement Communities
- Short-term facility-based care organizations
- Home and Community-Based Care organizations

The Best Practices Showcase is an awards-based initiative, with three top winners chosen from the entries. They will receive special recognition including, but not limited to:

- **A cash prize of \$1,000**
- A plaque suitable for display
- Winning project showcased on FPN website as well as other collaborating organizations
- Invitation to participate in the Florida Pioneer Network's Best Practices Showcase
- Teleconference, to be held in Spring of 2020.
- FPN will nominate winners to be showcased at national and state conferences
